Her colleagues and former boss, IL Secretary of State, Jesse White are honoring her on Thursday, April 25, 2013 at 1:30 P.M. at the Ethnic Heritage Museum, 1129 South Main Street, Rockford, Illinois 61101.

A reception hosted by the Ethnic Heritage Museum's Polish Gallery honoring Vikki's heritage will immediately follow the ceremony.
