- There is no cost to the donor's family or estate for donation. The donor family pays only for medical expenses before death and for funeral expenses.
- In the United States, it is illegal to buy or sell organs or tissue for transplantation.
- It is possible to donate life to others as a living kidney or partial liver, lung, intestine or pancreas donor.
