- ▶ Please complete an entry form for each art submission. Entry forms should be attached to the back of each piece of artwork.
- ▶ All entries should be postmarked by **January 31, 2024**. Please mail submissions to the following address:

- ▶ Entries will be divided into the following four categories:
  - Category 1: grades K-2
  - Category 2: grades 3-5
  - Category 3: grades 6-8
  - Category 4: grades 9-12
- ▶ Artwork must be submitted flat without any folds or bends. The preferred size is 11" x 14" poster board.
- ▶ Artwork may be created using crayons, ink, paint, colored pencils or markers. Due to reproduction/printing issues, artwork with chalk, oil or glitter, or artwork that has been laminated will not be accepted.
- ▶ Artwork must be original and hand drawn. No computer-aided designs or graphics will be accepted.
- ▶ Artwork with copyrighted characters (e.g., Disney characters) will not be accepted.
- ▶ Artwork should broadly reference organ and tissue donation, not one specific organ or tissue.
- ▶ Posters will be judged on readability, general design, creativity and message.
- ▶ All submissions become the property of the Illinois Secretary of State and may be reproduced.
